

Lenten Study, February – March 2024

Jesus: The God who Knows Your Name by Max Lucado
You believe Jesus is God. But do you also think of him as a *real person?*

For 33 years Jesus felt everything that we have ever felt: weakness, weariness, rejections. His feelings got hurt. His feet grew tired. His head ached. To think of Jesus in such terms almost seems irreverent. It is much easier to keep his humanity out of the incarnation. Clean up the manure from around the manger. Pretend he never snored or hit this thumb with a hammer. There is something about keeping Jesus divine that keeps him distant, packaged, and predictable. But we have to remember that the people who saw Jesus first...saw him first as a person.

As Max Lucado reveals in this video Lenten Study, because Jesus became human, it is now possible for us to see God and hear his voice. If we want to know what matters to God, all we need to do is look in the Bible to see what matters to Jesus. If we want to know what God is doing in our world, we need only ponder the words of Jesus. By learning more about the person Jesus was and is, we come to understand more clearly the people we were created to be.



FROM THE PASTOR

February 2024

Come now, let us reason together, says the Lord, though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool.

Isaiah 1:18

Dear Friends,

We have recently sung a hymn called Jesus Paid it All (All to Him I Owe) and as we approach the Lenten season for 2024 let's look closer at its history. It has been stated that all religious systems can be spelled with just two letters—D O. The gospel of Christ, however, is spelled with four letters—D O N E! This hymn text, written by a lay woman named Elvina Hall, speaks pointedly to this basic truth, which is the very basis of our Christian faith. In 1965 she wrote these words on Sunday morning during the pastor's sermon and lengthy pastoral prayer at Monument Street United Methodist Church in Baltimore, Maryland. Apparently, she started thinking of all that Jesus had already done to provide for her salvation and was overcome with words that just had to be written down. Not having any paper handy she used the flyleaf of a hymnal!

Her words went along hand-in-glove with the church's organist, John Grape, who had recently composed a tune but had no words for it. It was first published in 1874 and is still sung in our churches today. The refrain goes Jesus paid it all-- all to him I owe; sin had left a crimson stain—he washed it white as snow.

In February we begin the season of Lent —that of reflection, contemplation, repentance, and spiritual discipline. We find the beginning of lent in Ash Wednesday, followed by five weeks of Lenten study (being held at the Yates City church's sanctuary.) I encourage you to find the words of this hymn and use them as a study in your devotional time. For when we truly realize that God, through Jesus Christ, has done everything for us, we can only give him our praise and thanks!
